- **CASH AND INVESTMENT.** This report is in your material for review.
- **BUDGET.** The BOC receives the proposed budget tonight. The Board will hold budget hearings on June 3 at the scheduled meeting and the Board will consider adoption of the recommended budget on June 17.

SIGNIFICANT PROJECTS AND ACTIVITY

- **ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.** I attended a Teams meeting with a manufacturer interested in the Thor Building. I assisted building inspection in a meeting with a developer and his attorney regarding a proposed convenience store and gas station at the corner of Hwy 225 and Newtown Church Rd.
- **175th ANNIVERSARY OF THE GORDON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE.** The Sheriff's Auxiliary hosted a memorial to fallen officers and tribute to the creation of the GCSO 175 years ago.
- **MOCK TRIAL.** I participated as a mock Judge in mock trials for two groups of third graders. My takeaway is that these students are very smart and creative.
- **PUBLIC WORKS AND PUBLIC FACILITIES COMMITTEE.** Commissioner Abernathy hosted this meeting and received reports from the road department, fleet and building and grounds.
- **REDBONE RIDGES.** We filed storm water reports on the EPA website. There were no violations indicated in the report.
- **PROJECTS.**
 - Multi-Purpose Facility. We expect a GMP proposal on June 2.
 - Mount Olive. All necessary easements acquired and call with Contractor for start date in late summer. The Contractor is currently determining suitability of borrow sites.
 - Ranger. Playground equipment has been ordered. Amended contract on agenda tonight.
