

## NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The **Gordon County Board of Commissioners** has tentatively adopted a 2025 millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes of **9.89** percent.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on this tax increase to be held at the County Judicial Building, 101 S Piedmont Street, Calhoun, GA on **September 2, 2025, at 12:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M.**

Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase are at the County Judicial Building, 101 S Piedmont Street, Calhoun, GA on **September 16, 2025, at 6:00 P.M.**

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of **9.042 mills**, an increase of **.814 mills**. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than **8.228 mills**. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of **\$250,000** is approximately **\$79.77** and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of **\$225,000** is approximately **\$73.26**.

Generally, property owners who benefit from the Homestead Exemption will not see an increase in the county government portion of their property taxes.
