
1. We have examined all criminal cases presented by the District Attorney's Office and reported Fifty (57) True Bills and One (3) No Bills.

- (5) Mr. James Ledbetter, Administrator, Gordon County Government


All financial reports have been examined, and all are accepted as submitted.

4. We authorize our Foreperson to call this Grand Jury back into session any time during our appointed term, if he warrants it necessary.




